KULWANT SAMRA'S COVID STORY

Donors to TB Vets Charitable Foundation have played a critical role during the pandemic by providing our hospitals with life-saving respiratory equipment like ventilators.

Sick and isolating at home in June 2020 after testing positive for COVID-19, Kulwant Samra had just enough energy to make it outside before he collapsed in front of the paramedics he had called minutes before.

Rushed to Royal Columbian Hospital in New Westminister, the 51-year-old Abbotsford man woke up in intensive care two months later. "I had tubes in my mouth, nose, and everywhere," he recalls.

"I cared for him early on in his illness when he was on life support," notes Dr. Steve Reynolds, a critical care physician whose research into ventilators is funded by TB Vets. "I came back a few weeks later, and you can imagine my surprise and pleasure at seeing him sitting up, waving and waiting to go home."

The generosity of TB Vets donors helps British Columbians like Kulwant recover and return to their families.

TB VETS PROVIDES REVOLUTIONARY GIFT TO ASTHMATIC PATIENTS

Into his 60s, Martin Beint only knew life as a severe asthmatic. It restricted what he could do, forced him to constantly carry an inhaler, and as a young boy in England led his family to send him to a boarding school on the coast in the belief that sea air would alleviate his symptoms. As an adult, he required annual steroid treatments. But Martin's world finally opened up a decade ago after a medical procedure that has now allowed him to put his inhaler away.

"It's been a tremendous improvement to my lifestyle," he explains. "I no longer carry my inhaler with me. It's in the car, but I know that I can get there wherever I am at."

With the generosity of donors to TB Vets, this life-changing treatment remains an option for others like Martin. Known as bronchial thermoplasty, the three-part procedure that Martin received has been a revolutionary gift.

But before he could reach this newfound freedom, Martin faced a low point in his life as an asthmatic. A severe attack in 2010 left him hospitalized. He was then put on a waiting list for bronchial thermoplasty.

The procedure, offered as an option for those who are unable to control severe asthma with other therapies, uses gentle heat to target the muscles in your lungs that tighten during asthma attacks.

When Surrey Memorial Hospital needed the equipment to provide this type of care, donors to TB Vets stepped forward to make it happen.

Before his treatment in 2012, Martin required his inhaler as many as ten times a day. Walking up a flight of stairs could leave him breathless. Exercise was out of the question. But since undergoing the procedure, Martin has not had a single asthma attack, hasn't needed steroid treatment, and feels transformed.

"While it hasn't made me into a marathon runner, certainly my quality of life has improved," he says.

For over 75 years, TB Vets has given hope to individuals and families in their hour of great need. Donors like you are helping others from throughout British Columbia who are struggling with life-threatening breathing complications.



TB VETS FULFILLS PRIORITY RESPIRATORY EQUIPMENT IN BC INTERIOR

The new HAMILTON-T1 transport ventilator funded by TB Vets donors has made it possible for Royal Inland Hospital (RIH) in Kamloops to provide better care in the Emergency Room and at rural sites in the Interior.

A much-needed upgrade for better respiratory care

The two trauma bays in the Emergency Department at RIH are used daily, sometimes multiple times a day. One already had a HAMILTON-T1 ventilator, but the second bay was equipped with an older, outdated equipment that was close to end of life.

With its graphic package feature, the new T1 ventilator from TB Vets allows clinicians to better visualize what is happening in real time. Not only is it more user-friendly and technologically advanced, it can also be used on neonatal, pediatric, and adult patients – all of whom can be treated in the Trauma Room. Having less cumbersome, updated and reliable ventilators in both of the trauma bays – often used for life-and-death situations – is paramount for the large teams of medical professionals working together in a small space.

Moreover, the portability of the T1 ventilator allows it to be used in most rural and remote sites, which provides familiarity among the frontline and, thus, better support over the phone, prior to the High-Acuity Response Team (HART) arriving for patient transfers from these smaller sites back to Royal Inland.

Royal Inland Hospital's Emergency Department sees over 70,000 visits per year, and its trauma centre is the third busiest in the province. As one of only two tertiary (specialized) care hospitals in the Interior of British Columbia, RIH serves a large geographic region and a population of 220,000 and growing. Due to its geographic location, surrounded by natural resources, busy highways and an abundance of recreational opportunities, the hospital provides life-saving care to both local residents and many visitors to the region who require immediate medical treatment, often unexpectedly.

TB RECREATION THERAPY

Support from TB Vets continues to be so important to recreation therapy interventions by allowing me to personalize interventions to each patient's needs and interests, be it a desire to have a small garden in their room to care for, a model car to build, a personalized photo book for reminiscing for a patient with dementia or art supplies for patients to be creative.

A significant change on the TB unit during 2021 was patient access to going outside. Previously, the policy was to allow patients to leave the unit only when accompanied by the recreation therapist. One patient in particular was very appreciative of being able to go outside on his own as his son, daughter-in-law and four young grandchildren had re-located to Vancouver from the East coast while he was in hospital recovering from TB. The joy on this man's face when he came back from celebrating his birthday with family he had not seen in person for six years was absolutely priceless.

Because the patient population on the TB unit is so culturally diverse, providing culturally-relevant leisure activities is a must. This year Douglas College recreation therapy program students researched activities that would appeal to Punjabi, Mandarin, Cantonese and French-speaking patients, and provided suggestions for all the requested languages, as well as step-by-step directions for each activity in both English and the original language.

As in previous years, the iPads are very popular. Beyond the typical entertainment apps, our patients also use them to stay in touch with friends and family. We had two instances where patients virtually attended funerals for family members. One was a patient admitted to us from Whitehorse, Yukon, whose father unexpectedly passed away while in the Philippines. By using our iPad, she was able to participate virtually in traditional ceremonies important to her culture during a most difficult time.

I am always impressed with how our TB patients handle having to be in hospital for such a long time, but I know that they are able to in part because of the support from TB Vets. We asked patients who were transferred from other hospitals, where some of them had left treatment against medical advice, what they found most helpful at the TB unit at VGH. One patient said: "I'm a very social person. Here I can wander around, meet people and even go outside. At the other hospital, they wouldn't let me out of my room and I only saw staff for a few minutes a day. It felt like a prison." This contrasting experience speaks volumes to the impact TB Vets support has on the quality of life of our patients, and how it helps them complete their treatment. So on behalf of all of our staff and especially patients, thank you!

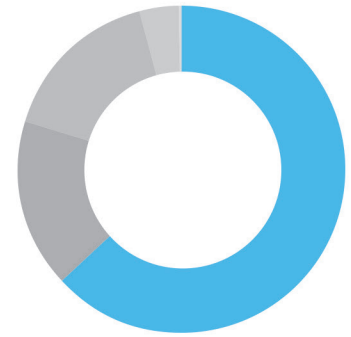
THE POWER OF GIVING

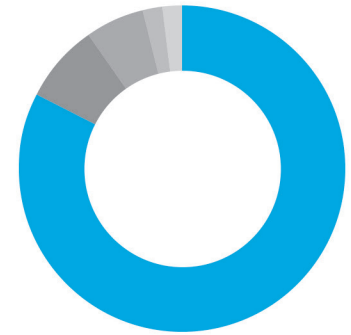
